

Frozen Egg



Hook: Typical Egg Hook

Body: Orange, Yellow, and Shrimp pink ice dubbing, pulled together into a strand and tie on top of the hook, pulled upright, and clipped just like egg yarn in a glow bug.

While tying streamer patterns this summer, I stumbled across a neat way to use a synthetic material called ice dub. Due to the nature of this synthetic material, it can be pulled into strands and used almost like a yarn. This makes it useful for tying egg flies and the heads of bulky streamers.

This lends itself well to the type of egg flies you might use in the winter. Using this material, you can make small, translucent egg flies that are good imitations of the brown trout eggs that are in a river in the winter. This fly works in a variety of different colors, though pale yellow mixed with orange are among my favorites. Both trout and steelhead will find this fly hard to resist.
