

# R.L.E.

## Recipe:



**Hook:** Daiichi 2461 size 1/0 or other large streamer hook 3x1 or longer

**Eyes:** Lead eyes (optional)

**Tail:** A few strands of purple marabou, and a few strands of purple sili legs

**Body:** Emu feather, wound forward, interspersed with sili legs as a wing

**Collar:** Sili Legs, a mallard flank, and sunburst flashabou

**Head:** Deer hair of your choice, Australian Possum, or ram's wool.

This is an attractor version of a popular steelhead fly, the emulator. The Rubber Legged Emulator is an effective fly for a variety of species. In olive and tan color schemes, it is good for many predators. When tied purple as pictured or when tied yellow, it is an exceptional smallmouth bass fly that has a knack for getting large fish to eat.

It can be difficult to find certain colors of rubber legs. Though fly shops often have a good selection, don't hesitate to look for spinnerbait or jig skirts at your local sporting goods store.
