

Pattern Sheet for Reflector

Materials:

Hook: Daiichi 2461 Size 2-6

Tail: Black, chocolate brown , or olive Marabou

Hackle: Olive Schlappen palmered through body

Body: Olive Ice Dub

Collar: Large Mallard Feather

Eyes: 2-4 medium bead chain eyes tied under hook

Head: Clump of olive ice dub on top of hook behind eyes

Flash: Holographic gold flashabou, topped with mix of red, gold, and green flashabou

How to Tie this Pattern:

Step 1: Cover the hook with Thread and lash the eyes on the bottom of the hook, $\frac{1}{4}$ the length of the hook behind the eye of the hook. Bring thread to rear of hook.

Step 2: Tie in a Marabou feather for the tail.

Step 3: Lash in a schlappen feather ahead of the tail, dub a body forward to cover $\frac{2}{3}$ the hook, and palmer the schlappen through it.

Step 4: Wind a mallard collar in front of the body.

Step 5: Tie in the flash above the body, starting with the Gold, and topped with the mix of colors.

Step 6: Just behind the eyes, add a clump of ice dubbing as a head. Olive or Peacock Ice dub is ideal.

Comments: This is the brightest fly to use on a bright and sunny day. If there is an aggressive fish around, this fly will draw his attention in the sunlight.
