

## **Printable Tying Instructions for Bass Detector:**

### **Materials:**

**Hook:** Daiichi 2461 or Equivalent streamer hook, size 1/0-4

**Tail:** Amber colored SAAP body fiber (Amber or light yellow antron)

**Flash:** Gold Holographic flashabou or fluorescent pearl krystal flash (or both!)

**Wing:** Yellow Bucktail on top and bottom of hook

**Body:** Yellow deer body hair followed by light yellow ice dub, orange ice dub, chartreuse and olive ice dub

**Eyes:** 4-6 brass bead chain eyes or plastic bead chain if you want a slower sink rate.

**Markings:** Berry, brown, or orange Sharpie marker to paint bars on the side of the fly

### **Tying Instructions:**

**Step 1:** Cover the hook with thread tightly, bring the thread to the rear of the hook.

**Step 2:** Tie in a tail of yellow or amber body fiber, antron, or the like.

**Step 3:** Top the tail with holographic gold flashabou.

**Step 4:** Add a clump of yellow bucktail above and below the hook shank. This will help to keep the antron from fouling.

**Step 5:** Clump or spin a small bunch of yellow deer hair around the hook.

**Step 6:** Tie a clump of light yellow ice dub on top of the hook, followed by a clump of orange ice dub under the hook, followed by a clump of chartreuse ice dub over the hook, followed by a clump of olive ice dub over the top of the hook.

**Step 7:** Lash 4-6 brass bead chain eyes under the hook, just behind the eyes. Finish the fly.

**Step 8:** Take a brown or olive sharpie and mark 4 bars on the tail and side of the fly. Trim the head of the fly flat on top and bottom.

**Comments:** This is an excellent slow sinking fly that fishes well in moderate depths.
