When chasing resident fish, our we offer patient instruction to the beginner. For the expert, we are on the river hundreds of days per year and can help you hone your game.

In addition to all the resident species, hordes of large migratory fish such as steelhead, lake run browns, and king salmon enter the Muskegon River and other West Michigan streams. Our specialty is streamer fishing for these fish. There is no experience in fresh water like a chrome steelhead on a swung fly. Peak seasons for steelhead and salmon afford a great chance for someone new to the sport to catch a large, hard fighting fish using a variety of fly fishing methods..
