### **Fire Diver:**

#### **Materials Needed:**

- Large Bass Bug hook or light wire streamer hook
- Heavy Thread
- Yellow, pink, and/or pearl krystal flash
- Yellow Pearl or Orange Flashabou
- Yellow Bucktail
- Orange Deer Body Hair
- Orange, red, and chartruese ice dub
- Red, orange, berry, or olive permanent marker

#### **Steps for tying this fly:**

1. Cover the hook with thread.
2. Tie pearl (or yellow) krystal flash, top with yellow pearl or orange flashabou.
3. Tie in long yellow bucktail above and below the hook.
4. Spin two large bunches of orange deer hair around the center of the hook.
5. Make the front of the head out of clumps of orange, yellow, red, and/or chartreuse ice dub.
6. Trim the deer hair and the ice dub to desired shape. Foam can be subsituted for deer hair.
7. Tie off the fly
8. Use the sharpie marker to paint desired stripes on the side of the fly.

Comments: I recommend using a bite guard with this fly as the pike really like it. Don't be afraid to throw large sizes, even for smallmouth, as they are deadly!
