

Grapefruit Spey:

Materials:

Hook: Up eye spey hook, size 1-6

Tail: Tuft of Chartruese Ice Dub, Topped with Hot Pink Ice dub and Flashy Blue Ice Dub (optional)

Hackle: Blue Eared Pheasant or Black Marabou, half stripped

Body: Phosphorescent Pink tinsel and peacock ice dub

Flash: Combination of Green, Silver, and Blue Flashabou or holographic purple

Tying Instructions:

•1. Cover the hook with thread using tight wraps and bring the thread to the back of the hook.

- •2. Tie in the two tufts of ice dub (chartruese over hot pink)
- •3. Wind rear 2/3 of hook with phosphorescent tinsel
- •4. Tie in a black marabou feather or blue eared pheasant by its tip.
- 5. Dub the peacock ice dub for the remaining part of the body.
- •6. Add the different colors of flash above and below the hook in layers.
- •7. Finish the fly.

Comments: This is a reversed version of a favorite winter fly. It is easy to cast and fishes well in moderate depths/cold water.
