Hairy Canary:

Materials Needed:

- 4xl Streamer Hook of your choice
- Heavy Thread
- Two Yellow or Amber Saddle Hackles
- Two Symmetrical Mallard Flank Feather
- One large Mallard flank feather for the collar
- Blue, holographic pink, and holographic gold flashabou
- Orange, red, and olive ice dub
- Red, orange, berry, or olive permanent marker

Steps for tying this fly:

1. Cover the hook with thread.
2. Tie in one mallard flank feather at the halfway point of the hook so that the remainder or the feather covers the back of the hook.
3. Tie in the two saddle hackles so that they too slope over the back of the hook.
4. Sandwich the yellow feathers between a second mallard flank feather.
5. Add an overwing of the different colors of flashabou.
6. Tie in the large mallard flank by the tip and wind it in place as a collar.
7. Tie in a clump of orange ice dub on top of the hook as part of the head. Follow this with a clump of red ice dub underneath, followed by a clump of olive ice dub on the very front.
8. Tie off the fly.
9. Use the sharpie marker to paint a stripe on the tip of the saddle hackles.

Comments: This fly is great for big brown trout and if tied with more gold flash is also good for smallies. This fly must be stripped sharply to produce results.
