Halloween Leech:

Materials Needed:

- Daiichi 2461, Size 4-1/0
- Fuschia Cactus Chenille, large
- Hot Orange and Peacock Ice Dub
- Holographic Pink, Holographic Black, and Copper Flashabou
- Black Marabou
- Large Mallard Flank Feather
- Lead Eyes to suit local conditions

Steps for tying this fly:

1. Cover the hook with thread and return thread to the front of the hook.
2. Tie in lead eyes 1/4 of the distance back from the eye of the hook .
3. Return thread to the rear of the hook and tie in some black marabou for the tail.
4. Tie in a dark schlappen feather and dub in a peacock or olive ice dub body
5. Wind the schlappen through the body, which ends 3/4 the way up the hook.
6. Tie in the mallard feather and take a couple wraps with it, making it the collar.
7. Tie in the pink flashabou as a wing above and below the hook. Repeat this process with the copper and then finally the black.
8. Behind the lead eyes, take a few wraps of the fuschia chenille and tie it off.
9. In front of lead eyes, tie in a veil of orange ice dub.
10. Tie off the fly.

Comments: This fly has been a staple for the last several years and continues to produce.
