### **Halloween Spey:**

#### Materials Needed:

- Daiichi 2161, Size 1
- Fuschia Cactus Chenille, medium
- Hot Orange and Peacock Ice Dub
- Holographic Pink, Holographic Black, and Copper Flashabou
- Black Marabou

#### Steps for tying this fly:

1. Cover the hook with thread and return thread to the upper part of the ben of the hook.
2. Make two wraps with the fuschia cactus chenille and tie it off.
3. Above the chenille, add a pinch of hot orange ice dub.
4. Tie in a few strands of the holo pink flashabou and wind it forward as the rear part of the body. Pull the excess back as part of the wing when you are 3/4 the way up the hook.
5. Strip half the marabou feather, dub the remaining quarter of the hook with the peacock ice dub, and palmer the marabou through the ice dub, leaving small gaps.
6. Top the fly with a little black marabou and some copper and holographic black flash.
7. Tie off the fly.

Comments: Holographic chartreuse or gold flashabou can be substituted for the pink, and seems to work a bit better when the sun is out. This fly is easy to cast and catches plenty of fish.
