



Fly Pattern Sheet:
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Simple Dry Fly Pattern:

Materials needed:

- Size 10-16 dry fly hook, to match your local insects.
- Thread of your choice, but it must be strong enough to bind deer hair.
- Bleached Elk Body Hair (ginger colored).
- Gray dyed or natural deer body hair.
- Amber or gray antron (optional).
- Yellow pearl or other colored crystal flash.

Tying Directions:

1. Cover the hook with thread.
2. At the back of the hook, tie in a couple strands of crystal flash.
3. Move thread 3/4 the way up the hook.
4. Tie in a clump of deer body hair so it surrounds the hook, move the thread to the back of the hook and then to the front in criss cross fashion.
5. At the 3/4 point forward from the bend, tie in a wing of the elk hair on top of the hook, as you would for an elk hair caddis. If you want more sheen under the wing, add some antron fibers.
6. Finish the fly.

This is a very simple pattern that can be changed to imitate many insects. It floats well and is easy to see amongst a blanket hatch.
